



## Request for Proposal for Animal Welfare Programs

Funding Focus:

### **Animal Welfare: To Care, Protect and Educate**

Proper care of and respect for animals is an ongoing community need. The Community Foundation seeks to promote humane treatment of animals, provide for the welfare of animals and educate the public about responsible pet ownership.

The Community Foundation of Broward is once again pleased to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for programs that support one or more of the following areas (listed in order of priority):

1. Animal Population Control in Broward County
2. Animal Welfare Programs in Broward County

Issues relating to each area of need:

#### **1. POPULATION CONTROL**

- Spay and neuter pets
- Reduce stray populations
- Place abandoned pets in forever homes
- Promote population control and adoption to key demographics

#### **2. ANIMAL WELFARE PROGRAMS**

- Access to services available by pet organizations such as pet adoption, spay and neuter programs, and veterinary care (low cost vaccinations, etc...)
- Prevent Animal abuse
- Provide pet therapy programs
- Educate the public about animal welfare issues and responsible pet ownership
- Partner with school district, civic associations, parks and recreation centers, etc... to increase audience reach

**Proposal Deadline:** Proposals must be *submitted through PhilNet* by 5:00 p.m. February 29, 2012.

**Grant Notification:** April, 2011

**Project Period:** May 2011 through May 2012

**Eligibility:** Nonprofit - 501(c) (3) community based organizations, Governmental agencies in Broward County.  
Proposed program must serve Broward County.

**Amount Available:** \$61,000
